Church Hall Speakers: Will be installed soon. Chair of Council: Discussion on urgency of having a council chair. B.6.1.2. of the UCC Manual was shared "The chair is responsible for a) chairing all meetings of the congregation or pastoral charge except for meetings called by the regional council; If the regional council calls a meeting of the congregation or pastoral charge, the regional council decides who will chair the meeting. It may be the chair of the annual meeting or some other person. b) taking votes and announcing the results; and c) voting only if there is a tie." CORRESPONDENCE: Thank you card from Rev. Steve Berube for funeral service coverage in Aug. FINANCIAL REPORT: Finances continue in downward trend overall. Positive - Sept offerings were higher than 2023. Rentals are helping. Cumulative loss is less than 2023, but spending is more than we're generating. In Sept the approved \$25,000 plus donated shares were transferred to the operating fund. VISIONING: Simplified Governance: will explore options. Reducing Carbon Emissions: Need person to take lead on "reducing and reusing". Suggestion for bin for plastic bottles/cans. Diversity: Education on diversity is critical and educational webinars available. We must ensure newcomers are both valued and welcomed. Diversity added to all Visioning meeting agendas. Education pieces will be incorporated into services. Kindred Works: small group met recently with consultor to discuss after school project and received some new perspectives for rentals. Application made to the Planning Advisory Committee for an exception to allow a small afterschool program to be run. 100th Anniversary: More use of UCC resources and continued sharing of info in weekly email. Website: Still needs to be updated. Flooring replacement for choir loft: Moved that the carpet be removed and replaced with vinyl flooring by Fabulous Flooring for \$3200. Motion Carried. UCW guilt raffle: Moved to allow UCW to hold a guilt raffle. Motion Carried. Scouts- Pie Making Request: requested permission to use the church hall and kitchen on November 22 and 23rd Request approved. Membership Transfer: Moved to accept Trudy Steeves request of membership transfer. Motion Carried.
